


The beginning: the EU Arctic Cluster

Ambition

To give evidence-based advice to policymaking processes

To sustain the platform in a European Polar Coordination Office (EPCO) after EU-PolarNet 2 ends

- 2 Provide strategies for meaningful stake- and right holder involvement
 - Support the development of transdisciplinary and transnational Polar research actions
 - Interact with national funding agencies to develop synergies and optimise the use of resources
 - 5 Provide evidence-based policy advice to decision makers
- Support the implementation of sustained observation systems in the Arctic and Antarctic
- 7 Create a permanent European Polar Coordination Office (EPCO)


Working together


